The Ministry wishes to inform that, per the updated Travel Advisory dated 23 July 2021, the age at children will be permitted to enter Antigua and Barbuda without being required to present a RT PCR test for SARS-CoV-2 negative result of seven (7) days has been lowered from twelve (12) years to five (5) years.

In this connection, the Ministry wishes to advise that the forgoing provision **only** of the updated Travel Advisory will take effect from **August 1, 2021**. All other stipulated provisions are implemented with immediate effect.

The Ministry of Foreign Affairs remains extremely grateful for the valuable assistance of all concerned stakeholders in our joint efforts to provide a safe, enjoyable experience in Antigua and Barbuda to residents and visitors alike.
